

Crime in Delaware Quick Fast *Property Destruction - 2020*

The Federal Bureau of Investigation defines Destruction/Damage/Vandalism of Property as:

"To willfully or maliciously destroy, damage, deface, or otherwise injure real or personal property without the consent of the owner or the person having custody or control of it."



- Property Destruction Offenses accounted for 14% of all Group A offenses in 2020.
- Property Destruction offenses were associated with \$4.9 million in property damage.
- Most property damage was to cars and/or buildings and typically occurred at a home/residence.
